RÖSSING MARATHON CHAMPIONS RECEIVE DEVELOPMENT BONUSES

The 2013 Rössing National Marathon champion, Paulus Iyambo, was awarded a development bonus worth N\$20 000 at the Namibia Defense Force's sport division in Windhoek.

Alina Armas, winner in the Ladies Open category of the marathon, also received N\$20 000, but could not attend the handover event because of her representing Namibia at the World Athletics Championships in Moscow at the time. Both athletes are members of the NDF sport club in Windhoek.

Rössing will stage the 23rd Namibia National Marathon Championship next year and the popular event will again be hosted in Swakopmund on Saturday, 15 February 2014. The marathon received record numbers of runners from all over Namibia in 2013 and the company expects the same support again next year. Paulus, who has been plagued by injuries this year, is confident that he will be back to defend his title in 2014. In receiving the development bonus Paulus said: "I have started training again and will be working hard to make a successful return. With the help of the development bonus from Rössing I have been able to recover much faster and get back into top shape."

Bonus Two last

The Rössing National Marathon Championship is an important event through which aspirant runners can attempt to qualify for the major South African long distance running events later in the year.

As usual, there will again be attractive cash prizes associated with next year's marathon and entries to the event will be announced in the media early next year.
