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SCOPE OF WORK FOR MAINTENANCE OF AIR-CONDITIONING UNITS AND REFRIGERATION PLANTS

SERVICES REQUIRED

The Contractor shall:

Carry out planned and unplanned maintenance to air-conditioning and refrigeration units located at the Mine Site, Swakopmund, Arandis and Walvis Bay Acid off-loading facility.

Carry out installations of air-conditioning and refrigeration units as the need arises.

Provide 24 hour call-out coverage to abovementioned services.

All the above services to be carried out to Rössing's Health, Safety and Environmental and other relevant standards.

Rössing shall:

Provide the Contractor with a designated work area inside the Mine maintenance workshop from where the Contractor shall operate.

TYPES OF AIR-CONDITIONING AND REFRIGERATION UNITS

There are a variety of units across the mine. Some of the units are installed in critical areas such as Information Technology Services, Metallurgy/Chemical Laboratories, Electrical Installations, etc. These installations are critical for continuous operations and must be attended to promptly in cases of breakdown.

There are various units installed in Mobile Mining Equipment consisting of Shovels, Haul Trucks, Earthmoving Equipment etc. These units are normally subjected to planned maintenance cycles. Air-conditioners installed in mining equipment are regarded as critical. Immediate response to breakdowns is therefore of paramount importance.

Other units include office air-conditioners, water fountains, chillers, and other miscellaneous units.

DETAILS

The contactor shall perform work as per instructions issued under the Services Contract containing the scope as per the tender process. The contractor shall ensure adequate supervision and supply suitably qualified and experienced workforce to deliver the service successfully to Rössing.

The Contractor is expected to provide a suitably qualified supervisor to supervise all work performed under this contract.

Relevant qualifications and training certificates of the Supervisor and crew members, approved by suitable authority, will be required to be submitted with proposal.

Rössing Mine operates under the highest safety and housekeeping standards. All Contractors working on the mine are subject to Rössing's Safety Standards and the Contractor must comply with these standards.

STANDARDS

For all work on site you will be required to be familiar with and to apply the relevant HSE and Rössing Engineering Standards.

When applicable, specific additional standards and procedures, such as OEM requirements, will be indicated as work/services are allocated via specific scopes of work/service.

When applicable, written Safe Work Procedures will be referred to and work must adhere strictly to these procedures.

SAFETY

All work will be carried out safely and the contractor shall supply and see to it that all his personnel at all times wear the appropriate safety clothing. Minimum requirements are safety hats, protective foot wear, safety spectacles and overalls.

Work permits, clearances, hot work permits etc. must be obtained on a daily basis before any work commences.

Risk assessments needs to be done by all workers prior to the commencement of a job or task to ensure all potential hazards are identified and eliminated.
