

Johannes !Gawaxab to resign as Rössing Uranium chairman

Rössing Uranium Limited chairman, Johannes !Gawaxab, has informed the board that he intends to resign from the board of the company in order to focus on other business commitments.

Mr !Gawaxab said: “It has been a great privilege to chair Rössing over the past two years, during which time I have worked with some outstanding people across the business. Unfortunately the expansion in activities of the private equity fund that I co-founded makes it increasingly difficult for me to dedicate sufficient time and effort to perform my duties as chairman of the Rössing board.”

Mr !Gawaxab joined the Rössing board in November 2015. He will remain chairman until such time that a successor has been appointed and a smooth handover has taken place.

The Rössing board is profoundly grateful to Mr !Gawaxab for the way in which he led the company during very challenging market conditions and wishes him success in all future undertakings.

Uranium was discovered in the Namib Desert in 1928, but it was not until intensive exploration in the late 1950s that much interest was shown in the area. After discovering numerous uranium occurrences, Rio Tinto secured the rights to the low-grade Rössing deposit in 1966. Ten years later, in 1976, Rössing Uranium, Namibia’s first commercial uranium mine, began operating and celebrated its 40th year of production in 2016.
