## Superintendent: Asset Management

Reporting to the Manager Maintenance, the successful candidate will be responsible for the facilitation and control over the Rio Tinto Asset Management process for the mining and processing maintenance teams, compilation of scheduled maintenance plans, site wide execution of relevant condition monitoring activities, reliability engineering and execution of major maintenance. The functions also include the compilation of procedures and strategies for the cost effective and timely execution of scheduled maintenance. Regular analysis of data is required to enable prioritisation of work and effective and efficient utilisation of resources.

### Key performance areas

- Enforce all set standards/ensures that all subordinates adhere to their personal safety plans;
- Supervise and ensure that subordinates complete their tasks according to set plans, defines clear priorities to ensure production continuity;
- Ensure that efficient and pro-active planning activities are carried out so that equipment availability and reliability are maintained well to ensure production targets are met;
- To operate cost effectively and to optimise resource utilisation, ensuring that improvements resulting in a more reliable plant are identified and implemented;
- To provide expert engineering input to assist subordinates and peers;
- Ensure the improvement of reliability of equipment, improvement of quality of workmanship and to increase the uptime for production purposes;
- Assist and compile a maintenance zero based budget for processing plant and mining;
- Recommends improvements to processes and discuss with other foremen involved in the process.

### Minimum qualifications

- Grade 12
- A recognized Bachelor's degree
- Minimum five years working experience in a mining maintenance environment of which three years should have been in Asset Management.
