Key performance areas

Minimum qualifications

- For N6 and T3 qualification – Qualified Artisan plus five years practical post apprentice experience preferably in an industrial electronic / instrumentation / electrical environment;
- For S4 qualification – Two years practical post qualification experience preferably in an industrial electronic / instrumentation / electrical environment;
- Code BE driver's licence.
