Superintendent: Workshops

Key performance areas

- Ensure a Zero Harm culture by demonstrating commitment to reduce personal injuries and implement HSE improvement projects, including but not limited to:
 - Conduct area audits and inspections;
 - Risk assessments;
 - Perform personal safety interactions; and
 - Manage critical controls and attend all relevant safety training.
- Monitor, review, modify and enforce maintenance schedules and standards;
- Audit compliance;
- Forecast – equipment/machinery replacements and scheduled maintenance;
- Audit contractor's performance;
- Identify problems impacting on quality, analyse/evaluate and establish corrective measures;
- Set, implement, monitor and take remedial steps where necessary of new standards;
- Set quality control plans and inspection regimes of major equipment and monitor the compliance thereof;
- Cost management; and
- Continuous improvement.

Minimum qualifications

- Grade 12;
- A recognised BSc / B Eng / B Tech degree in Mechanical or Electrical Engineering;
- Minimum five years working experience in a mining maintenance environment of which three years should have been in a supervisory position and managing major / multiple contractors;
- Training in SAP is advantageous;

- Registered as a Professional Engineer or Incorporated Engineer will be an added advantage;
- Previous experience in the maintenance of processing plants would be an added advantage; and
- Valid code BE driver's licence.
