Advisor: Fire & Emergency Response

A vacancy exists for a position of Advisor: Fire & Emergency Response within the HSE & Protection Service department. The primary purpose of this role is to protect the company's assets from damage due to fire/explosion and to provide a comprehensive emergency service to Rössing. The successful candidate will be responsible for administering the company's business resilience and recovery management plan (BRRP), and introduce actions that would reduce the company's insurance premiums to the lowest level possible. The role will also respond to medical emergencies, taking charge of overall emergency response operations in the absence of the Superintendent Protection Services.

Key performance areas

- Emergency management;
- Administration - emergency management;
- Provides a quick and efficient emergency response capability for fire calls;
- Directs investigation to determine origin and cause of fires and if required, present evidence in case of suspected arson;
- Staff supervision;
- Safety management;
- Operational assistance;
- Prepare emergency plans for specific risks, (fire, flood, ammonia, U₃O₈), and ensures that all related support groups are trained on their specific actions;
- Other related duties as required or instructed by the Superintendent Protection Services.

Minimum requirements

- Grade 12;
- A recognised Bachelor's degree in Fire Science or Fire Safety Management or Emergency Management or Disaster Risk;
- Minimum of five years' working experience in a fire & emergency response services environment, of which three years should have been at a supervisory level, preferably in an industrial or mining environment;

- Intermediate Emergency Care Practitioner qualification will be an added advantage;
- Valid code C1E driver's licence.
