The mine is located 12 km from the town of Arandis, which lies 70 km inland from the coastal town of Swakopmund in Namibia's Erongo Region.

Rössing Uranium hereby invites interested service providers to submit their "Expression of Interest" (EOI) for being considered for pre-qualification evaluation for the above services.

Context of the Project:

Rössing Uranium is currently engaged in a Feasibility Study (FS) to extend the Life of Mine from 2026 by another 10 years, in line with their recently approved Mine License (ML28) extension to 2036.

The Feasibility Study (FS) will be completed by mid-2022 to inform an investment decision by the end of 2022 to prepare for a 2025 start date.

The Life of Mine Extension (LoME) Project is underpinned by a new pushback of the pit which is the lowest cost extension option available to Rössing.

The majority of the current HME fleet reaches the end of its life by 2026 and will need replacing and the Project Team are evaluating both Owner Mining and Contractor Mining options for LoME beyond 2026.

For the Contractor Mining option, a formal Tender Process will be followed to identify suitable companies to supply a full mining service.

The response required at this initial stage is an Expression of Interest from companies who wish to take part in the Tender Process.
